

# "COLON HYDROTHERAPY COURSE & INTESTINAL PURIFYING AND REGULATION (advanced)"

## What is Colon Hydrotherapy?

Colon Hydrotherapy, is a deep irrigation of the entire large intestine with filtered, purified water, through a tube inserted in the rectum. The cannula is a two-way system; during the session water enters on one side and exits several times during the session via another (waste tube).

The filtered water as well as pressure, temperature and flow rate are regulated by an electronic device controlled and managed by the therapist throughout the session.
